Reverse/Hold Vote for Frosh Concert:

- King Council came up with the decision to reverse the **decision to not vote in favor** of funding the forthcoming Frosh Concert from the King budget (SSF By law 10.08,10.09). In order to protect the interests of our student body and ensure the success of this significant event while making sure that campus operations run smoothly.
- During the past few days, 2-3 meetings were held by the King Council with our campus Manager to discuss the budgeting and expenses from the allocated campus budget obtained from the SSF services fees. We also had a meeting with Nicholas, the Finance manager of the Seneca Student Federation, to have a better understanding of the budget and understand what crucial steps we can take as the King Council to ensure that we spend the allocated money wisely in order to run the campus Operations smoothly and utilize the money obtained from the ancillary fees of the students by spending it for their betterment/improvement. According to the finance report provided by the Manager of Campus Operations-King Campus, Charanpreet Deu, we are in a deficit of **\$112,489.63**.
- **It was MOVED by Navdeep Singh, and SECONDED by Poornima Kalia, “that the vote for Frosh Concert should be either be reversed or should be put on a hold until we have a better understanding of the budget and the expenses of the fall semester”.**

In order to recover some money, the King Council has come up with various solutions on the campus level from certain events such as:

1. We will be charging the students \$ 4-\$ 5 for the Bear in Build Your Bear event.

3. Increasing the sales price for the variety store.
4. Wages for the staff will also be increased from October since the minimum pay will increase which makes the expense of staff wages higher from the overall budget.

After discussing all these exercises, Charan will create a report after receiving end of semester expenses report and will submit to the Council in the next LBC for discussion.
