- The practices are as follows:
  1. King council will be working to provide more inclusive and diverse events and instead of ordering full meals, snacks will be ordered to reduce the cost. Also, some events are put into reconsideration to save money by looking into first half of the semester.
  2. Activities Like build will be charged \$4 plus HST and also lunch sales will be noticed and if they do not go well, it will be stopped.
  3. Decorations: spending of \$100-\$200 cad is approved for the whole year
  4. More collaboration with department for cost reduction and provide student more educational/Awareness on campus life. (i.e. -Stress relief workshop with student life and they are paying half of the cost) Moreover, working with clubs like Beauty club to book them instead of having a vendor to reduce cost. Departments on collaboration with on-campus activities for Fall: (Student life, Counselling, York Health Region, Aramark, Recreation, Helix, Nursing School etc.)
  5. Variety Store: Sales are not too high on campus so the price is increased by 10% to see if it can help.
  6. IT's hard to do the staff reduction but more volunteers will be encouraged to come to help us but only issue is with accountability of work.
